NFMC National Conference Set for June

The National Federation of Music Clubs (NFMC) Biennial Convention will be held in Norfolk, Virginia from June 12 through June 17. All music club members are invited to attend.

The 2023 convention features a week of music, workshops, fellowship, and exploration. The convention will take place at the Sheraton Norfolk Waterside Hotel, located on the waterside in downtown Norfolk. The hotel location affords easy



access to dining, shopping, and sight-seeing.

Norfolk is a welcoming city and is excited to host the 2023 convention. Among the most popular visitor destinations are the Chrysler Museum/Perry Glass Studio; Nauticus Museum/Battleship Wisconsin, the MacArthur Memorial and the Norfolk Botanical Garden.

The 2023 Young Artists Competition, including a Winner's Concert, will be held at the hotel during the convention.

Activities include a specially curated dinner cruise along the Elizabeth River, offering spectacular views of the mighty ships and submarines of the Navy's Atlantic Fleet. The Festival Chorus, directed by Dan Anderson, will perform. Also, composer Jeremiah Evans will conduct a workshop on the compositional process.
