Missouri State News

Two of our senior clubs have been quite active this year and has a lot to share. The **Morning Etude Music Club** in St. Louis has been striving to come back strong after Covid. They have presented a tribute to jazz program, hosted a women's chorus to sing literature of American Women composers. They dedicated their December meeting to sacred music for the Christmas season and hosted singer Tess Florek to sing "I Know My Redeemer Liveth" from Handel's "Messiah".

They celebrated Founder's Day with a members' performance and watched short silent films from 1896. They continue to have wonderful guest from places like Opera St. Louis and plan a road trip to Opera in the Ozarks this summer.

The **Kansas City Musical Club** hosted its annual scholarship auditions March 2 and is awarding \$7,000 of scholarship funds to nine winners. The club hosts monthly concerts of talented area musicians from the three local music conservatories. On April 14 they will have a scholarship fund benefit concert featuring the winners of their scholarships this year. Kansas City composer Mark Hayes performed before a large crowd at their March meeting.

The **Kansas City Musical Club** has done a great job of keeping track of the former winners of their auditions that have gone on to having lucrative careers. These include Arten Kuznetsov, an audition winner in 2012 and 2013, who is also a winner of the Valsesia Musica International Piano Competition. Michael Coleman, bass, has sung with Tulsa Opera, Fort Worth Opera and Opera on the Avalon. Bassoonist Mark Lauer, a winner in 2015, performed with Northwest Florida Symphony and has been appointed as instructor at the University of Missouri-St. louis. Mezzo Alice Chung has had leads in Boston Lyric Opera and Hawaii Opera Theatre, Cellist Qizhen Liu has had an active career in San Antonio, Texas. Violinist Laurel Gagnon has soloed with Jacobs School of Music. Mickael Lipari-Mayer is studying at the Conservatoire Dukas in France. Kelli Jo Van Meter has soloed with Kansas City Symphony and teaches at Hastings College in Nebraska. Yezi Chen has opened a piano studio in Allentown, Pa. This is quite an impressive list.
